**CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT: BROOKS B. ELLWOOD**



Dr. Brooks B. Ellwood joined the LSU Department of Geology and Geophysics in 1999, coming here from the University of Texas at Arlington, where he had served as President and Vice President of the Faculty Senate, joined AAUP there, and is a life member of AAUP. At LSU he has served as the President of the LSU chapter of AAUP, and President of the State of Louisiana Conference of the AAUP. He is active in faculty support activities and regularly attends the ALFS (Affiliated Louisiana Faculty Senates) meetings of statewide faculty

members held in Alexandria, LA. He is currently a member of the LSU Faculty Senate.

**CANDIDATE FOR VICE PRESIDENT: OLIVIER MORÉTEAU**



Dr. Olivier Moréteau joined the LSU Law Center in 2005, as a Chaired Professor of law. His former position was at Université Jean Moulin, Lyon, France, where he served as Director of the Comparative Law Institute. Moréteau is the Director of the Center of Civil Law Studies at the LSU Law Center, and is a member of the Council for Research at LSU. He joined the AAUP on his first year at LSU and served as Chapter Secretary (2011-2014) and as Acting President (2014-2017). In the past several months, he has worked at building a new LSU Chapter website and at feeding the news section. He is active on the dismissal of tenured faculty front and the redefinition of LSU email policy.

**CANDIDATE FOR SECRETARY: BRYAN J. MCCANN**



Dr. Bryan J. McCann is Assistant Professor in the Department of Communication Studies. Since joining the LSU faculty in 2013, he has been engaged in shared governance and campus advocacy in a variety of capacities. He presently serves as secretary for the faculty advocacy group LSUnited, serves on the College of Humanities and Social Sciences Faculty Senate, and has been a member of the LSU chapter of AAUP since arriving on campus. In his current capacity as AAUP Acting Secretary, Dr. McCann helps schedule meetings and has participated in the development of the new chapter website. Prior to

arriving at LSU, he was a faculty member at Wayne State University in Detroit, where he was active in the AFT/AAUP faculty union.

CANDIDATE FOR TREASURER: KENT MATHEWSON



Dr. Kent Mathewson joined the LSU Department of Geography & Anthropology in 1988. Prior to this he taught in pre-doctoral contingent faculty positions at a number of universities including UNC-Chapel Hill, Virginia Commonwealth, and several campuses in the University of Wisconsin system. At LSU he has served multiple terms as AAUP Treasurer, and terms on the Faculty and College (HSS) Senates. He has worked to recruit members and publicize AAUP events and activities.
