The Pinchot Institute recently brought together more than 60 participants including representatives of US pellet producers, European purchasers, U.S., Canadian, and European policymakers, and conservation organizations met over two days to analyze and debate complex sustainability issues related to the growing trade in wood pellets between the U.S. and Europe.



Organized by the Pinchot Institute for Conservation and the International Energy Agency (IEA) Bioenergy Tasks 40 and 43, the Savannah workshop explored the potential application of sustainability criteria being developed by European governments and industry.
