



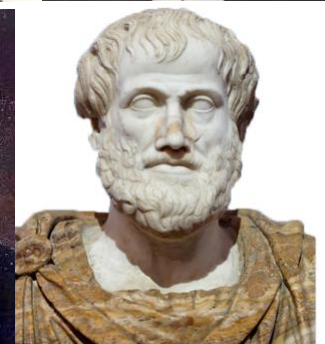
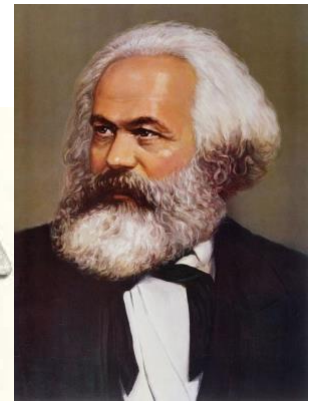
Announcing a continuing opportunity for LSU students:
